Before You Arrive

In advance of your event, you will be emailed a link to our digital Consent and Release Forms. A separate form must be completed for <u>each</u> participant. The forms include sections for you to declare any medical conditions, food allergies, and dietary or other restrictions. Please complete these sections accurately so that we may prepare appropriate accommodations.

Accessibility

The Roar & Snore campsite has paved pathways to all key areas, accompanied by areas of uneven and unpaved terrain. Weather and clothing

Roar & Snore Safari is an all-weather event. Please wear appropriate clothing for weather and temperature conditions. Overnight attire, comfortable close-toed shoes, and clothing for the following day are recommended.

Check-in

Roar & Snore Safari check-in is from 4:15 to 5:00 PM in the Preferred Parking section of the Safari Park parking lot (above row 1). Starting at 4:15, Roar & Snore Safari guests may park in the Preferred Parking section at no additional charge. Please bring your luggage from your vehicle to the check-in area. Any additional guests not enrolled in Roar & Snore Safari will not be admitted to the program.


