SUMMER CAMP 2017**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are so excited that you and your child will be joining us for Summer Camp at the San Diego Zoo Safari Park! Your child is enrolled in a 5-day camp from 9:00 am to 11:00 am each day. Campers, along with one of their favorite grown-ups, will enjoy play and interactive learning, mini Park tours, up-close animal encounters, story books, and lots of hands-on activities to give your tot a fun introduction to Summer Camp at the Safari Park. The following information will help you and your camper prepare for the best time at Summer Camp:

This program is specifically designed for children ages 2-3. Proof of your child's age may be required, and all campers must be at least 2 years old by the first day of their camp session.

Each camper must have one adult with them to accompany them at camp. (Exception: Adults may bring up to two children as long as both children are ages 2-3 and both children were pre-registered for the program). Sorry, no siblings under 2 are permitted.

PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL: DOWNLOAD your Summer Camp ticket and complete your release form.

You will receive two emails: One email, containing your ticket, will be from "esales@sandiegozoo.org". The Summer Camp ticket will be used for entry into both the Parking Lot and the Safari Park main gate on the first day. A second email, containing a link to your release form, will be from "Safari Park Summer Camp via DocuSign". This link allows you to complete all of your release forms electronically. If you do not complete the release form through DocuSign then you will be required to complete a paper release on the first morning of camp. You and your child cannot attend camp without this completed release.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT INSTRUCTIONS:

8:45 am – 9:00 am: Summer Camp Check-In

Meet at the log ring, located behind Guest Services.

9:00 am: Summer Camp Begins

If you arrive late, please go to Guest Services and they will contact the counselor to arrange for you to meet up with your group. It may take a few minutes to locate your counselor, so it is best to be on time. We do not want you or your camper(s) to miss out on the fun in the Park!

11:00 am: Summer Camp Ends

Your counselor will end the program in the Safari Park, allowing you to stay and enjoy the Park if you prefer.

WHAT TO BRING:

- ✓ **Ticket and signed release form:** **You must have a ticket and a completed release form on the first day of camp. You only need to complete a paper copy of the release if you choose not to use DocuSign.**
- ✓ **Snacks**
- ✓ **Reusable Water Bottle:** This is **highly recommended** to keep you and your camper(s) comfortable.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- ✓ **Sunscreen**
- ✓ **Hat/visor**
- ✓ **Comfortable, closed toe shoes for you and your child(ren):** Walking is a part of the program, but strollers are OK. All paths are ADA accessible.
- ✓ **Shorts/Pants/Skirts/Dresses that are OK to get dirty**
- ✓ **Safari Park Summer Camp 2017 T-Shirt:** Upon check in on the first day, your child(ren) will receive a Summer Camp t-shirt. Campers must wear this year's Summer Camp shirt to camp every day. If you would like your camper to have more than one shirt, or would like to purchase a shirt for yourself or a family member, additional t-shirts are available for purchase at check-in on Monday for \$15 each.

- ✓ **Electronics**
