Before You Arrive

In advance of your event, you will be emailed a link to our digital Consent and Release Forms. A separate form must be completed for each participant. The forms include sections for you to declare any medical conditions, food allergies, and dietary or other restrictions. Please complete these sections accurately so that we may prepare appropriate accommodations.

Accessibility

The Roar & Snore campsite has paved pathways to all key areas, accompanied by areas of uneven and unpaved terrain. For guests seeking our most accessible tents, please discuss with our Reservation Sales team at (619) 718-3000. - ✓ Tent accommodations

- ✓ Bar (All Ages and Adults Only events. Cash, card, Apple Pay, and Google Pay accepted.)
- ✓ Restrooms available at the campsite (please note: showers are not available)
- ✓ Classic Tents include sleeping pads
- ✓ Vista Tents include cots, fan, and space heater
- ✓ Premium Tents include a queen bed with pillows and linens, cots with sleeping bags, fan, and space heater

Weather and clothing

Roar & Snore Safari is an all-weather event. Please wear appropriate clothing for weather and temperature conditions. Overnight attire, comfortable close-toed shoes, and clothing for the following day are recommended.

Check-in

Roar & Snore Safari check-in is from 4:15 to 5:00 PM in the Preferred Parking section of the Safari Park parking lot (above row 1). Starting at 4:15, Roar & Snore Safari guests may park in the Preferred Parking section at no additional charge. Please bring your luggage from your vehicle to the check-in area. Any additional guests not enrolled in Roar & Snore Safari will not be admitted to the program.

What to bring

Each participant should bring the following items, clearly labeled with their name. Please limit luggage to one sleeping bag and one duffel/suitcase per person.

- Safari Park admission ticket or proof of membership
- Appropriate clothing
- Sleeping bag and pillow*
- Personal toiletries
- Flashlight**
- Medications (note: the Safari Park staff is unable to dispense medications of any kind)
- Adults, bring I.D. or proof of age

*Pillows, linens, and sleeping bags are provided for guests staying in Premium Tents.

**For the safety of wildlife, please do not shine flashlights into habitats or at wildlife.

Optional but recommended

- Reusable water bottle
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Extra blanket
- Insect repellent
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen

Please DO NOT bring

- ⊗ Candles, matches, or lighters
- ⊗ Coolers
- ⊗ Cots or air mattresses
- ⊗ Powered inflation devices
- ⊗ Space heaters
- ⊗ Two-way radios

Items not allowed at the Safari Park

For your safety and the safety of wildlife, the following are not allowed on grounds. For a full listing of prohibited items, see zoo.sandiegozoo.org/help-center

- ⊗ Alcohol (excepting beverages purchased inside the Safari Park)
- ⊗ Glass bottles or containers
- ⊗ Marijuana, marijuana-enriched products, and any illegal substances
- ⊗ Open-speaker radios/music players
- ⊗ Balloons
- ⊗ Sporting goods/equipment
- ⊗ Any throwing/kicking toys
- ⊗ Roller skates or shoes with wheels
- ⊗ Drones or remote control toys
- ⊗ Ride-on toys or transportation devices (other than approved mobility devices)
- ⊗ Lawn or folding chairs
- ⊗ Masks or costumes
- ⊗ Pets
- ⊗ Throwaway lids and straws
- ⊗ Weapons of any kind, including toy ones
- ⊗ Any other items deemed by Safari Park Management to create a safety hazard

The San Diego Zoo Safari Park is a smoke-free facility (including e-cigarettes and vapor inhalers).

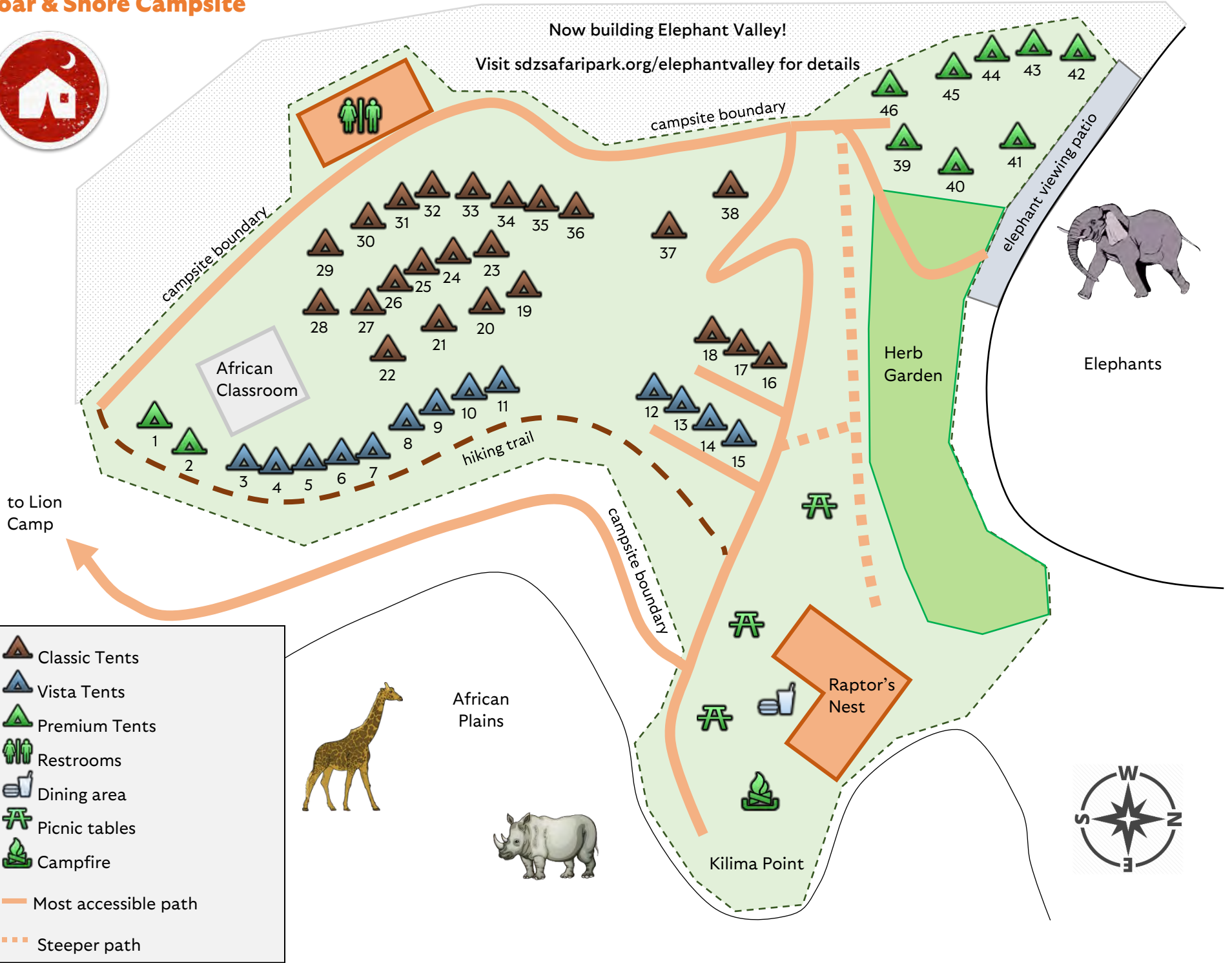
